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Crochet pattern for the Open Access logo

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REPOSITORY RECORD

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Open Access Logo

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Equipment:

- 4mm crochet hook (G-6)
- Double knit yarn in orange and white

Abbreviations:

- ch: chain
- inc: 2 single crochet in the same stitch
- sc: single crochet
- sl: slip stitch
- st: stitch
- sts: stitches

Notes:

- Number of sts per row is given in {curly brackets}
- Repeats are shown in [square brackets]
- All worked in rows
- Pattern is in US terminology



Part A

1. With orange, sc 6 into a magic circle, join with sl, ch1 {6sts}.
2. inc in each st, join with sl {12sts}. Change to white.
3. [sc, inc] x 6, join with sl, ch1 {18sts}.
4. [sc x 2, inc] x 6, join with sl. {24sts}. Change to orange.
5. [sc x 3, inc] x 6, join with sl, ch1 {30sts}.
6. [sc x 4, inc] x 6, join with sl. {36sts}. Fasten off.

Part B

1. With white, sc 4 into a magic circle, ch1, turn {4}.
2. inc in each st, ch1, turn {8}.
3. [sc, inc] x 4, ch1, turn {12}.
4. [sc x 2, inc] x 4, ch1, turn {16}.
5. sc x 3, change to orange, keeping the tail and white in front, inc, [sc x 3, inc] x 3, ch1, turn {20}.
6. [sc x 4, inc] x3, sc x 2, change to white, sc x 2, inc {24}. Fasten off, and mark the 12th st.

Sew Part A to Part B to form lock shape. Make sure the lock's opening is on the left.

Border

1. Join with white into marked st. inc, sc x 5, inc, sc x 12, [inc, sc x 5] x 2, inc, sc x 12, inc, sc x 5. Join with sl. Fasten off, and sew away ends.
